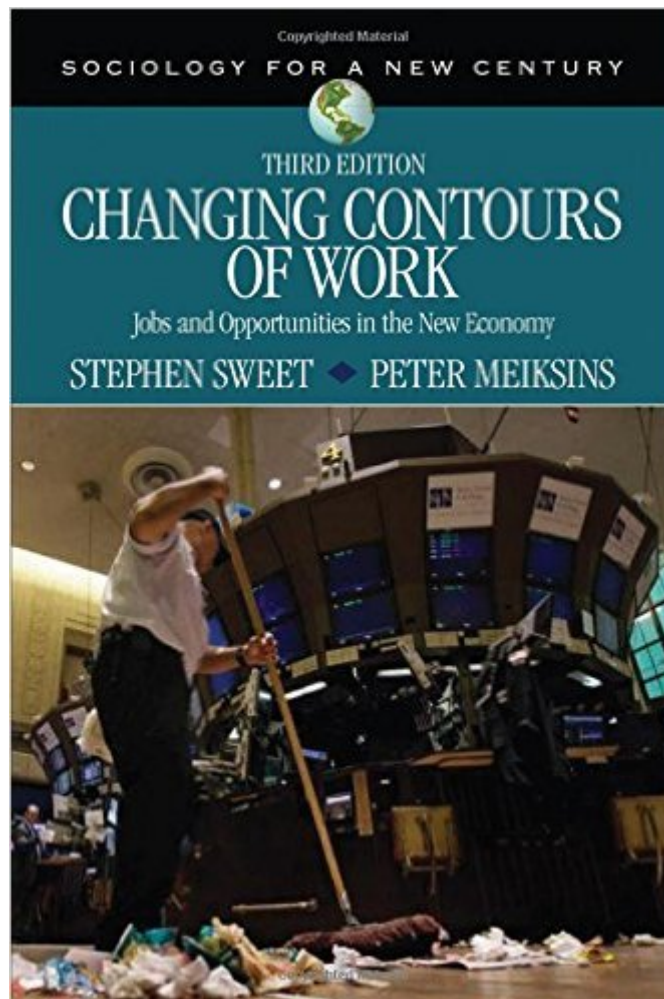


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Changing Contours Of Work: Jobs And Opportunities In The New Economy (Sociology For A New Century Series)
